

OMCAN Privacy Notice 2019

Data protection

In the course of communicating with OMCAN you have (or will) provided information about yourself ('personal data'). We (the University of Oxford) are the 'data controller' for this information, which means we decide how to use it and are responsible for looking after it in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation and associated data protection legislation.

The information we collect

We collect your contact details which always include your name and email address, but possibly also include the name of the organisation you work for, your job title, a contact telephone number, your work address and your scientific interests. We do not seek to collect any sensitive personal information. We also collect information that is generated by your engagement with us such as details of the events and meetings you attend and projects you collaborate on. We may also take photographs at events you attend.

How we use your data

We will use your data to provide you with the services of interest to you that OMCAN provides to organisation representatives and its members. The range of services includes providing you with the opportunity to participate at events and to be involved in research collaborations facilitated by OMCAN.

If you are associated with an organisation with whom we have (or with whom we are working towards having) a contractual relationship involving you, then we need to process your data in order to fulfil our contractual obligations.

In the absence of a contractual relationship relevant to you we will process your data for the purpose of providing you with the services of interest to you only because you have given us your consent to do so by, for example, responding to an email requesting your consent or by filling out a web form. You can withdraw your consent at any time by contacting us at omcan@maths.ox.ac.uk or by calling 01865 280615.

In this event, we will stop the processing as soon as we can. However, this will not affect the lawfulness of any processing carried out before your withdrawal of consent.



We will only use your data for the purposes for which we collected it, unless we reasonably consider that we need to use it for another related reason and that reason is compatible with the original purpose. If we need to use your data for an unrelated purpose, we will seek your consent to use it for that new purpose. For example, we might ask whether we can mention you on our website.

Who has access to your data?

Access to your data within the University will be provided to those who need to view it as part of their work in carrying out the purposes described above. OMCAN may share your data with students and academics at the University of Oxford in order to deliver the services of interest to you.

We may also share your data with the following organisations for the reasons indicated.

- UK Research and Innovation/ other funding bodies

We may need to report to funding bodies about engagement and impact.

- Other organisations

We may want to share your details with other individuals associated with OMCAN when we believe it will be helpful for all those involved to do so. For example,

- 1) we may provide an email introduction for those who might like to collaborate;
- 2) at a networking event we might mention you to someone likely interested in your work.

Where we share your data with a third party, we will seek to share the minimum amount necessary.

Retaining your data

We will retain your data for at most 6 years from the last date on which you gave consent for us to hold your data. You can withdraw your consent at any time by contacting us at omcan@maths.ox.ac.uk or by calling 01865 280615.

Security

Where we store and use your data

We store and use your data on University premises and potentially on University provisioned services within the European Economic Area (EEA) in electronic and manual form.

Electronic data may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside the EEA, for example, when we communicate with you using a cloud based service provider that operates outside the EEA such as Doodle Poll/Survey Monkey/MailChimp/Eventbrite/Wuhoo/etc.

Such transfers will only take place if one of the following applies:

- the country receiving the data is considered by the EU to provide an adequate level of data protection;
- the organisation receiving the data is covered by an arrangement recognised by the EU as providing an adequate standard of data protection e.g. transfers to companies that are certified under the EU US Privacy Shield;
- the transfer is governed by approved contractual clauses;
- the transfer is necessary for the performance of a contract with you or to take steps requested by you prior to entering into that contract; or
- the transfer is necessary for the performance of a contract with another person, which is in your interests.
